Governor's Directive 16-01

Handout – Draft of instructions and form that will be distributed to agency directors and CIOs. Highlights the importance of business involvement in projects. Office of the CIO (OCIO) was asked to do a few things:

1. Establish accountability in agencies
2. Conduct inventory of critical tech systems (By 01/29/16)
3. By the end of March, adopt policy

Scope of this directive is Cabinet level agencies, but the new policy will apply to all agencies.

Governor's Summit on Cybersecurity and Privacy

Summit held Jan 5 & 6 in Seattle. Federal, State and private sector represented. Focused on continuity of commerce. Some feedback from CIOs who were there:

- Security is a business issue. Look at it as “cost of staying in business.”
- Right people are working together.
- Govt/private partnerships are important.
- Good conversation of enterprise level risks.
- Good to have these every 2-3 years.
- Good summit, but found it difficult to have conversations in the sessions about current practices with enforcement agencies present.

IPMA session on June 8 will cover cyber issues.

Major Projects / Workgroup

PowerPoint slides. A workgroup is being formed to work on topics that will ultimately result in revision of Policy 121: IT Investments Approval & Oversight and related processes. This workgroup will meet periodically over a few months. This work will be done in parallel with discussions with the Technology Services Board. Ideally, this workgroup is comprised of people who work with the processes on a somewhat regular basis.
